About CCPR

The Chin Center for Peace and Reconciliation (CCPR) is a Chin-led peacebuilding and governance organization working in Chin State and along the Myanmar-India border. CCPR works with local communities and civil society structures to advance protection, governance, and durable peace in Chin State.

Background

CCPR is currently working on a civilian protection and humanitarian program in Chin State, covering 12 villages across four townships: Thantlang, Hakha, Falam, and Tedim. The program includes community training on first aid, EORE (Explosive Ordnance Risk Education), and emergency preparedness. The Assistant Engineer is responsible for day-to-day construction oversight in Falam and Tedim townships.

Key Responsibilities

Construction oversight & technical quality

- Oversee construction specifically in Falam and Tedim townships.
- Ensure the construction in these two townships meets the same construction standard and technical design applied across the project.
- Provide day-to-day, on-site supervision and coordinate with local labor and material vendors in Falam and Tedim.

Safety & capacity building

- Support safety compliance at Falam and Tedim sites, including safety netting and worker safety gear.
- Uphold humanitarian principles, including Do No Harm, safeguarding, and prevention of sexual exploitation and abuse (PSEA), in all site activities.

Reporting & documentation

- Report construction progress and issues in these two townships to the Civil Engineer and relevant officers.

Qualifications and Experience

- Bachelor's degree in civil engineering or a related field.
- Prior experience in on-site construction supervision.
- Based in or able to travel regularly within Falam and Tedim townships.
- Working proficiency in Chin (Falam or Tedim dialect) and Burmese; English an advantage.

Other Competencies

- Strong interpersonal, communication, and coordination skills.
- Upholding and promoting the highest standards of respect, honesty, integrity, and ethical conduct.
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision and take initiative where needed.
- Commitment to CCPR's mission, including safeguarding, prevention of sexual exploitation and abuse (PSEA), and Do No Harm principles.
- Flexibility to travel frequently to field locations under challenging circumstances.
